- 6. Why are society, the media and politicians fixated on the idea that the causes of poverty sit with the individual?
- 7. What might be the political rationale for shaming people in poverty?
- 8. What might be gained or lost if we made dignity rather than shame the guiding principle for how we discuss poverty and make policies to alleviate it?
